FACE Development Days

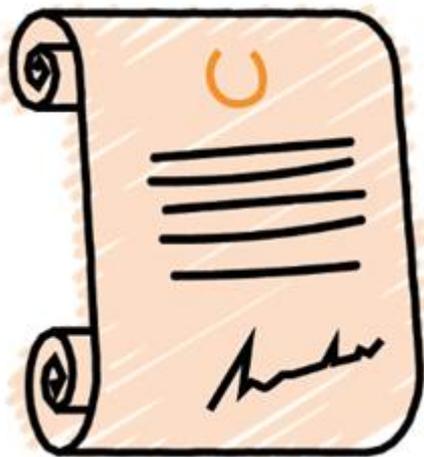
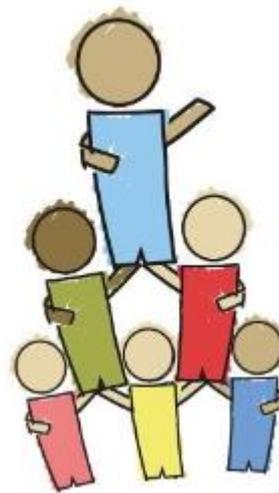
