Who can enter?

These awards are open to all Future-Focused Finance Value Makers. We will accept nominations of individuals or groups/teams of value makers. **You cannot nominate yourself.**

All entries must be received by 5pm on Friday 4th September 2020.



AWARD CATEGORIES

The Value Maker Award categories are the Future-Focused Finance 4 Strengths:



We will also be presenting a Finance and Clinical Educator (FACE) award for the FACE who has logged the most finance teaching hours within their organisation.

KEY ELEMENTS

An individual who:

Keeps their technical skills up to date with the latest thinking in Finance and focuses on the challenges facing the NHS. An individual who also supports others in the team to do their job.

Judging criteria:

- Evidence of how the individual keeps their knowledge and skills up to date.
- Evidence of how they support their colleagues/team to help them do their roles.
- Someone who has thinks outside the box and is the go to person for technical finance help.



KEY ELEMENTS

An individual who:

Understands that embracing & enabling change is part of their daily job. They develop and implement new ways of doing things to improve the services they give. Someone who always sees finance as part of the solution.

Judging criteria:

- An example of how the individual has been challenging and innovating at work.
- Someone who promotes the concept of continuous improvement through encouraging, listening to and acting on the ideas of others.



KEY ELEMENTS

An individual who:

Strives to increase value in every piece of work they undertake. Someone who “thinks like a patient and act like a tax-payer” when at work.

Judging criteria:

- Evidence that they understand the concept of value in healthcare run projects to increase value, assess ideas in line with value principles.
- Evidence that the individual takes a solution focused approach to problem solving and decision making.
- Someone who has shown they understand the wider system they work in.

KEY ELEMENTS

An individual who:

Engages fully with their team and contributes beyond their personal job description. An individual who also builds constructive relationships with clinical colleagues and decision makers beyond their team, department and organisation.

Judging criteria:

- Evidence of how the individual has built strong relationships and collaborates effectively with others across the organisation and system.
- Someone who remains positive in the face of difficulties and seeks to overcome challenges and is accountable for what they do.
